They continually identify specific supplies that are both critical to the care of our children and in short supply in the clinic.

Please consider packing a *Medical Clinic Survival Kit* to bring with you on your next trip. Also, please consider encouraging your friends, neighbors, and coworkers to support your ministry by providing additional *Kits* for you to bring in your suitcase. If you cannot assemble an entire *Kit*, please bring whatever you are able to collect from the list. Our clinic cares for thousands of patients each year, seeing as many as fifty patients per day. Your gifts to the clinic are greatly needed and will be used to care for the children and families of Cielo and Nazaret.

Medical Clinic Survival Kit

- Ziploc bags (various sizes)
- Pedialyte
- Formula – soy and regular
- Children's Tylenol and Motrin/Advil
- Antibiotic cream
- 1% hydrocortisone cream
- Lotrimin Cream AF
- Liquid hand soap
- Poly-vi-sol with iron (multivitamin for children)
- Emery boards
- Toothbrushes

Both children's and adult's antibiotics are all desperately needed. Samples and full-sizes are accepted.
